CozyCasts

Created a platform for streaming AI-generated podcasts to help you learn, or for entertainment. The backend is designed for scalability, while maintaining low latency and cost-conscience, and uses an API/worker pattern to decouple the compute-heavy TTS from the API.

PDF Word Count

Created an extension for Visual Studio Code and Open VSX compatible editors (such as Cursor), which displays the word count of PDF documents in the status bar, with more detailed statistics in the status bar tooltip.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP

2024–2025

Co-Founder — Ivy

Created Ivy with two former colleagues, as a spin-off from our previous company (Unify), with the blessing of their CEO. We adapted the existing framework to allow any ML models or code to be converted between frameworks such as PyTorch and JAX. The design of the transpiler involved advanced Python programming, including AST manipulation and function tracing. To create the customer-facing interface, I did significant backend development and DevOps using cloud infrastructure (GCP).

After interviewing with Y Combinator and talking to potential customers, we failed to prove commercial viability, so we ended Ivy as a venture and open-sourced the project - which is available on *GitHub* and *PyPI*.

- Developed the multi-backend framework Ivy; creating backend functions and tests, forming the CI, and reviewing PRs from contributors.
